Kamiwarizaki Campsite Rules

- *Please read*
- 1. Please enter the campground only after you've checked in at the tourist plaza. (Check-in starts at 1:00 PM and ends at 6:00 PM) If you are going to run later than 6:00 PM, contact the camp managers.
- 2. Check out is by 11:00 AM the next day: please check out on time. (Camping hours for day camp users is 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM)
- 3. Please follow the instructions of camp managers, follow the campsite rules, and do your part so everyone can enjoy their time here.
- 4. Cars are permitted around the tent sites/cabin area only when dropping off and loading your belongings. When you've finished unloading or loading, please move your car to the designated parking lot right away.
- *The parking lot spaces at campsite 4 are for emergency vehicles, so please don't park there.
- 5. Please refrain from getting drunk and disturbing this family-friendly place, and respect the lights-out/quiet time (starting at 10:00 PM)

Remember everyone else wants to enjoy this campground with you. Be especially careful not to disturb others during the nighttime.

- 6. Keep clean during your stay. Use the toilet and fire in designated areas/facilities only (note open flames aren't allowed) and be careful to completely extinguish fires.
- *Use fireworks on concrete and make sure to always have water on hand.
- *After you've finished, make sure ashes are totally extinguished and throw them away in the designated area.
- 7. Sorting garbage is mandatory. Please sort your garbage into burnable and unburnable garbage (bottles, cans and plastic bottles) and throw it away in the designated area.
- *See the other side of this paper for details.
- 8. Catching fish and shellfish on the beach counts as poaching: please don't do it.
- *We don't endorse fishing or playing in the water on the premises and you do so at your own risk.
- 9. We will charge for the cost of lost or damaged rental items.
- 10. Buried tent pegs in the ground can damage other tents, so please don't leave pegs in the ground and make sure to remove them all.
- *If a peg breaks in the ground or you can't get it out, please let campsite managers know.
- 11. People using the tent sites or cabins cannot use facilities on the auto campsite.
- 12. Auto campsite users, please respect the vehicle limit of one vehicle parked per site.
- *Move other vehicles to the parking lot under the auto campground.
- 13. If your pet is camping with you, please follow campground etiquette (for example, keep

your pet on a leash at all times and dispose of waste properly)

- 14. Try not to waste electricity and water.
- 15. You are responsible for protecting your own valuables while at the campground, including the parking lot.
- 16. We do not take responsibility for any dispute or trouble that takes place between guests.
- 17. Please obey any other instructions not listed here given by campground managers (including instructions given in an emergency).

*Violation of these rules can result in being ask to leave the campground at the campsite managers' discretion.

How to Sort and Discard Garbage

Thank you for reading these rules and sorting your garbage

Follow these rules when you throw away garbage in the campground's designated area.

- 1. Burnable garbage (no official garbage bag necessary)
- Please put burnable garbage into a bag and tie the opening closed tightly before throwing it away.
- Please crumble styrofoam into smaller pieces and throw it away inside a bag as burnable garbage.
- Throw cardboard away by folding it up and putting it in the marked location. Make sure to close the lid.
- After you throw away your garbage, make sure the garbage lid is totally shut.
- *This is to prevent local animals from getting into the garbage.
- 2. Unburnable garbage (bottles, cans and plastic bottles only)
- · Sort your garbage into bottles, cans and plastic bottles, and throw them away in their designated areas.
- *You are not allowed to discard any other kinds of unburnable garbage here.
- Please remove the cap and label from plastic bottles.

- Please remove the cap from glass bottles.
- Please sort your glass bottles by color:

(Clear bottles) (Brown bottles) (All other colors like blue, green, black, etc)

- *About garbage we can't collect
- If you have other kinds of garbage besides what's listed in 1 and 2 above, please take all of that garbage home with you.
- If you aren't sure about your garbage, check with staff before you throw anything away.

You cannot throw away gas cylinders, barbecue grills, batteries, or damaged tents at this campground.

This is everybody's garbage station, so please follow the rules and be neat so everyone can have a good experience. Thank you for your cooperation!
